Thursday, December 19 Winter Wonderland - wear your blue and white


Friday, December 20 *Ugly Sweater Day* - wear a Christmas Sweater, we will decide if its ugly or not!



In fiscal year 2024, Central Virginians recycled 58 million pounds with Central Virginia Waste Management Authority (CVWMA) and that was just at the curb!


Virginia requires our region to recycle 25% of our waste.

Buddy was a baby in an orphanage who stowed away in Santa's sack and ended up at the North Pole. Later, as an adult who happened to be raised by elves, Santa allows him to go to New York City to find his birth father, Walter Hobbs. He, who is on Santa's naughty list for being a heartless jerk, had no idea that Buddy was even born. Buddy, meanwhile, experiences the delights of New York City (and human culture) as only an elf can. Thinking of his wife, Mary, their four children, and others he loves will be better off with him dead, he contemplates suicide.
